

Attention Military Spouses!

You may be eligible for up to \$6000 in financial assistance under a new DOD program.

The Department of Defense (DoD) is expanding the Military Spouse Career Advancement Account (MyCAA) initiative to provide financial assistance to eligible military spouses seeking licensing, credentials and/or education for future or continued employment in portable career fields. Spouses married to an active duty or activated Guard or Reserve Service member are eligible to participate in MyCAA.

MyCAA provides up to \$6000 in grants for each participating military spouse. Grants are paid directly to Schools and other Payees using MyCAA's AI Portal (DoD's online invoicing system).

Many ODU bachelor's and Masters degree and licensure programs may be eligible to receive funding under this grant program. Among them are all Teacher Preparation programs, Military Career Transition Program, Engineering and Engineering Technology, Nursing, Business, and others.
